

## Different Types of Marquee & Tents

All these examples can be used at Gravel Farm

Traditional Pole Marquee



Classic & beautiful made of cotton canvas (photo courtesy of *Dottie's Marquees*)

Can be lined or left unlined (see photos below)

Sides can be rolled up or down, depending on the weather

Central poles can be decorated

(Sailcloth marquees look like trad marquees, but instead of cotton canvas, they use polyester sailcloth)

Clear Span / Frame Marquee



Flexible units which can be tailored to suit your requirements – units bolted together (photo courtesy of *Cambridge Marquees*)

More contemporary and can be hired with transparent ceiling etc

Can be lined or left unlined (see photos below)

No central poles

Stretch Tent



Perfect if you just need a shelter (photo courtesy of *Cambridge Marquees*)

Very stylish

No sides, but it can be anchored down to provide more coverage

Pagoda Marquee



Elegant and stylish (photo courtesy of *Cambridge Marquees*)

Great for smaller parties, with units bolted together to provide you with space

Can be lined or left unlined

Sides can be rolled up or down

Giant Hat Tipi



Super trendy and eye-catching

Quite cosy and dark inside

Individual 'hats' for dining, dancing etc

More expensive than conventional

Indian Raj Tent



Beautiful and totally different

Lined with Indian fabrics (which you can choose).

Rollable sides

More expensive than conventional
